JOB ANNOUNCEMENT

The Merced County Mosquito Abatement District will have an opening February 11, 2021 for:

Position: Seasonal Mosquito Control Technician

Work Location: Reporting Office: 14100 Deep Well Road Dos Palos, CA 93620

Definition: This position, under the general direction of the General Manager and direct supervision of the Operation Services Supervisor, is an entry-level position that performs inspections and control operations in an assigned zone or specialized function of a mosquito control agency and does related work as required. Examples of work includes surveying of areas for mosquito breeding and development sites, treating areas with a variety of physical, biological, and chemical control measures, interacts with the public on various matters involving aspects of mosquito control, and other related work.

Minimum qualifications: Must have a good presentation and poise; must have a valid California State Driver's License with a good record and insurability with the District's insurance carrier, using the accepted guidelines of the insurance provider. College education preferred. Graduation from High School or equivalent a must. Possession of mosquito control licensee from the California Department of Public Health or obtain certification with probationary period.

Working Conditions: Applicants must be physically able to perform manual labor, lift and carry weights in excess of twenty-five pounds, stamina to walk in and through pastures, rice fields, and wetlands; and to traverse rough terrain while carrying handcans, backpack sprayers and other mosquito control equipment.

Salary/Benefits: \$23.38 per hour. Forty-hour work week. Employment will be seasonal (ending in November). Health Insurance, Paid Holidays, Sick Leave, Vacation, Retirement, Worker's Compensation Insurance, and uniforms in season. Opportunity to earn over-time as needed.
